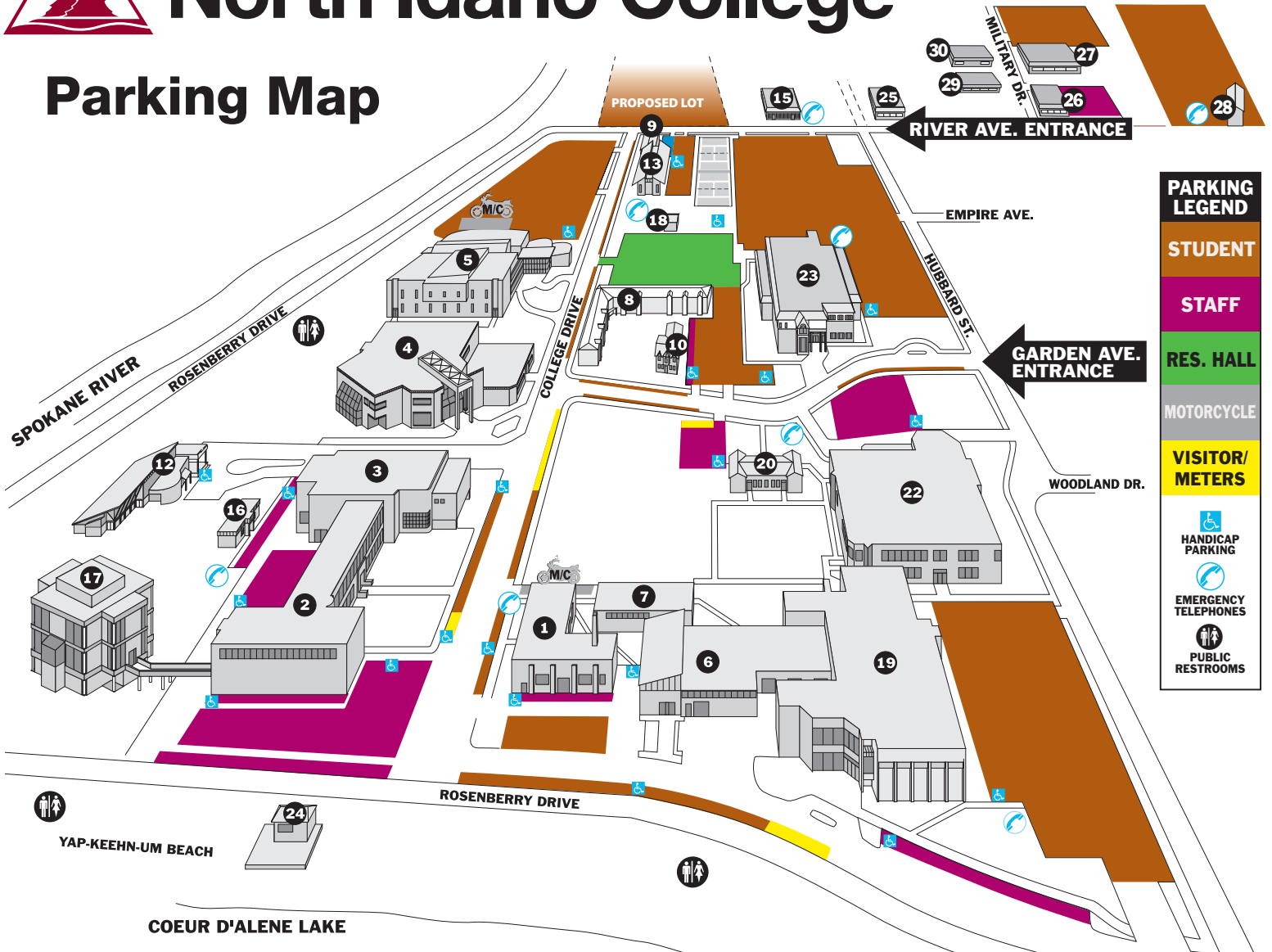

## Vehicle Registration & Campus Parking Information

All motor-driven vehicles on the NIC campus are required to be registered with the Parking Services Office. A permit tag must be displayed in the lower right-hand corner of the vehicle's windshield with the permit number clearly visible. Parking on Rosenberry Drive, Hubbard Street, and River Avenue are designated as no-pay parking areas. Parking permits are NOT required after 5 p.m.

### • Student/Employee Permits

Yearly Registration Permit Tags are \$20 for student, \$35 for staff. Your license plate number is required at the time of registration. Vehicle registration forms/permit tags are available in the Parking Services Office (or purchased during class registration). Payment is required at the time the permit tag is issued.

Students registering for Spring Semester pay a \$10 fee. Vehicle permits are not required for summer classes.

### • Short-Term Classes

Students attending short-term classes or workshops/classes offered by the Center for New Directions must purchase a permit for \$20. Students working towards their GED must purchase a regular student parking permit for \$20.

### • Visitor Permits

All campus visitors are required to either display a Temporary Parking Permit in their vehicle while visiting campus from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Friday or park in a metered parking space. Permits must be completed and signed by a designated office to be valid. Temporary Parking Permits are available from the Parking Services Office located in Headquarters Complex B, or the College Relations Office located in the Sherman Administration Building.

### • Tickets

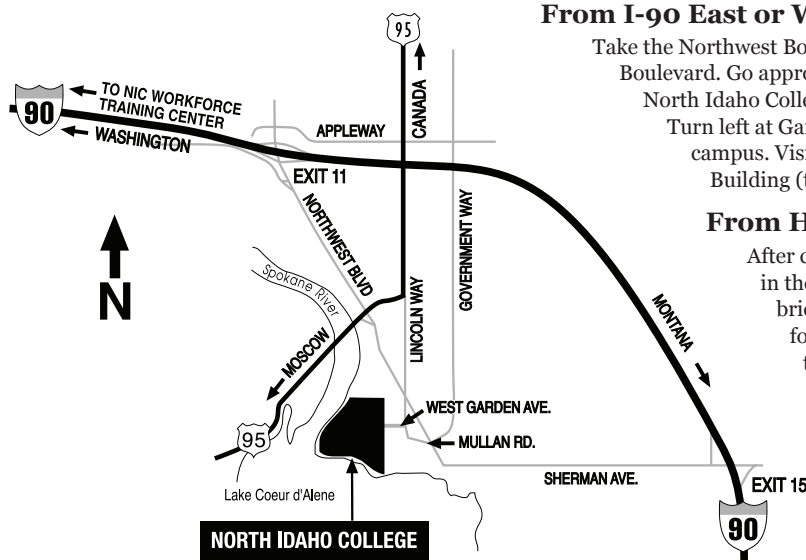
Illegally parked vehicles and/or vehicles without a visible permit will be ticketed.

Fines are payable at the Parking Services Office. The fine will be reduced if paid within seven (7) calendar days. Fines are not reduced for handicap and fire lane violations. An additional fine will be assessed if the fine remains unpaid after 30 days. **Please note that students with outstanding tickets will not be allowed to register until the fine has been cleared.**

### • Appeal Process

An appeal must be made within seven (7) calendar days of the date of citation. Forms are available in the Parking Services Office (ticket must be attached to the form).

## NIC Coeur d'Alene Campus: Driving Directions



### From I-90 East or West:

Take the Northwest Boulevard Exit (Exit 11) from I-90 and go south on Northwest Boulevard. Go approximately 1.8 miles to the third stop light (you will see a large North Idaho College readerboard on your right). Turn right onto Mullan Road. Turn left at Garden Avenue and after two city blocks you will enter the NIC campus. Visitor parking is located next to the Sherman Administration Building (the second building on your left as you enter the campus).

### From Highway 95 North:

After crossing Appleway continue to proceed south on Hwy. 95. Stay in the right lane and follow the signs to Moscow. Before crossing the bridge over the Spokane River turn left onto Northwest Boulevard, following the signs to City Center. Go approximately 1/2 mile to the first stop light (you will see a large North Idaho College readerboard on your right). Turn right onto Mullan Road. Turn left at Garden Avenue and after two city blocks you will enter the NIC campus. Visitor parking is located next to the Sherman Administration Building (the second building on your left as you enter the campus).

### From Highway 95 South:

After crossing the Spokane River turn right onto Northwest Boulevard, following the signs to City Center. Go approximately 1/2 mile to the first stop light (you will see a large North Idaho College readerboard on your right). Turn right onto Mullan Road. Turn left at Garden Avenue and after two city blocks you will enter the NIC campus. Visitor parking is located next to the Sherman Administration Building (the second building on your left as you enter the campus).

### Directions to Workforce Training Center:

From Interstate 90 take the Pleasant View Road Exit (exit #2) that is west of Post Falls. Turn south on Pleasant View Road to Riverbend Boulevard, turn west (right). Go to West Clearwater Loop (on your left) and turn south (left) into the Riverbend Commerce Park and proceed to 525 West Clearwater Loop.
