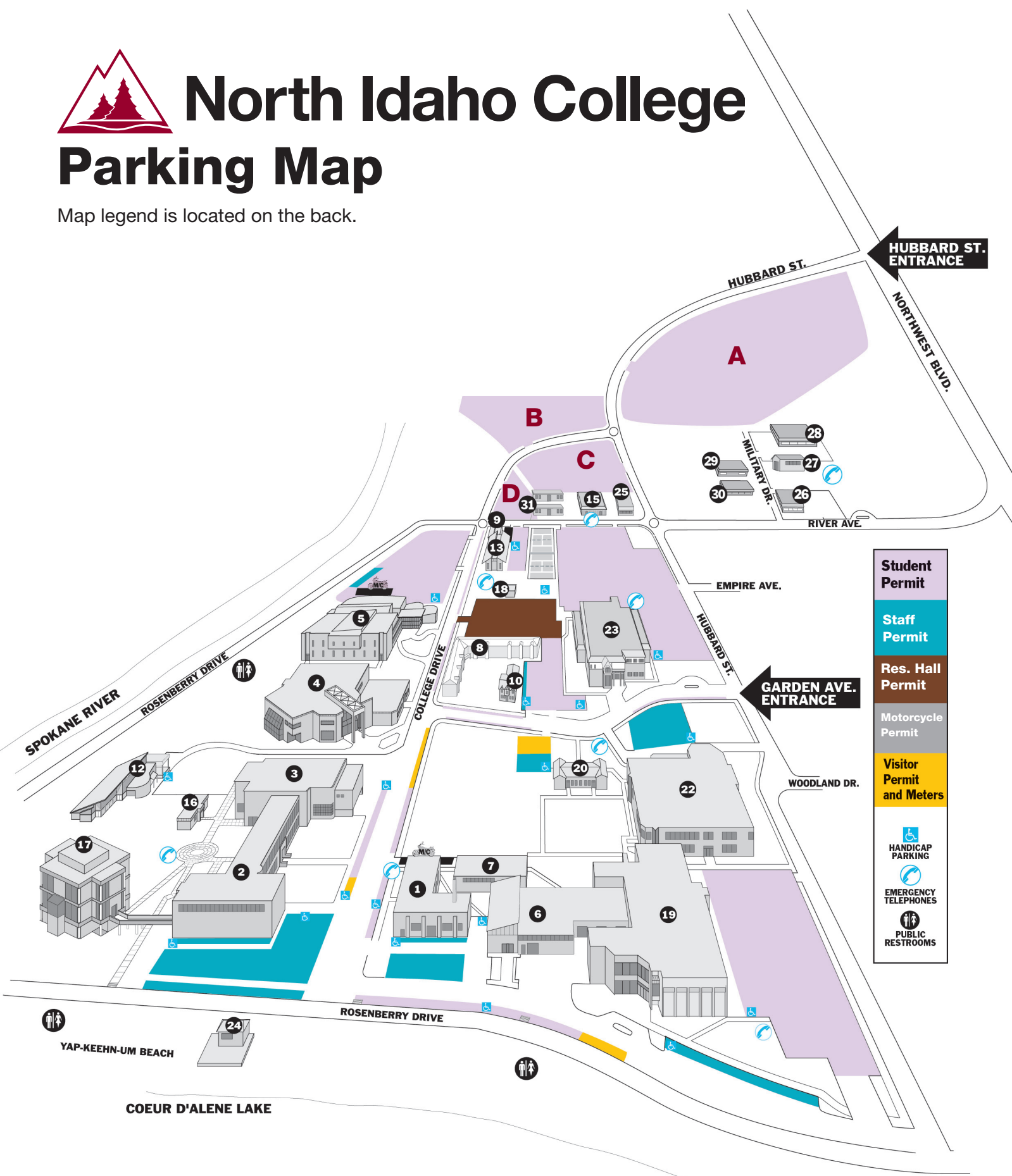




North Idaho College Parking Map

Vehicle Registration and Campus Parking Information

All motor-driven vehicles on the NIC campus are required to be registered with the Parking Services Office. A permit tag must be displayed in the lower right-hand corner of the vehicle's windshield with the permit number clearly visible. Parking on Rosenberry Drive and Hubbard Street are designated as no-permit parking areas. Parking permits are NOT required after 5 p.m.

• Student, Faculty, and Staff Permits

Yearly registration permit tags are \$30 for students and \$45 for employees. Parking permits are required from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 6 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Friday. License plate numbers are required at the time of registration. Vehicle registration forms/permit tags are available in the Parking Services Office (or purchased during class registration). Payment is required at the time the permit tag is issued. Students registering for spring semester only pay a \$15 fee. Vehicle permits are not required for summer classes.

• Short-Term Classes

Students attending short-term classes or workshops/classes offered by the Center for New Directions must purchase a permit for \$30. GED students must purchase a regular student parking permit for \$30.

• Visitor Permits

Visitor passes are required between 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Friday. Visitor passes are available from the Parking Services Office in the Headwaters Complex and the Communications and Marketing Office in the Sherman Building. A visitor is defined as any person other than a student, staff, or faculty member of North Idaho College.

• Tickets

Illegally parked vehicles and/or vehicles without a visible permit will be ticketed.

Fines are payable at the Parking Services Office. The fine will be reduced if paid within seven business days. Fines are not reduced for handicap and fire lane violations. An additional fine will be assessed if the fine remains unpaid after 30 days. **Students with unpaid parking tickets may lose course registration privileges and/or be placed on Academic Hold.**

• Appeal Process

An appeal must be made within seven business days of the date of citation. Forms are available in the Parking Services Office (ticket must be attached to the form).

To ensure a safe and healthy environment for students, employees, and visitors, North Idaho College is a tobacco-free campus. Smoking (including e-cigarettes), all modes of tobacco use, and tobacco sales (including smokeless tobacco products) are prohibited on NIC-owned, -operated, or -leased properties including parking lots, walkways, sidewalks, sports venues, and college-owned and private vehicles parked or operated on college property.
