

## CREDIT BY EXAM: ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

The Advanced Placement Program is available at various high schools throughout the country. It is sponsored by The College Board, Inc. Upon completion of the AP high school course, students sit for a national standardized exam to determine if the student is eligible for college credit.

If you wish to have your scores sent to North Idaho College, please indicate so on your AP materials. **The code number for NIC is 4539.** After the exam has been scored, NIC will receive an official AP report. Your results will be used to determine if you receive college credit.
