The vice president for Student Services (VPSS) or his/her designee shall compare the National Sexual Offender Public Registry with the college enrollment data base each semester to determine if sex offenders registered with Kootenai County are also concurrently registered as students. If so, the VPSS will initiate a meeting with the student to talk about an appropriate educational plan.

All students shall receive a correspondence with their admissions materials indicating that those with prior felony history with regards to Crimes Against People, Crimes Against Children, or Drug Offenses must notify the VPSS Office so that accommodations can be made to assure their educational success.
