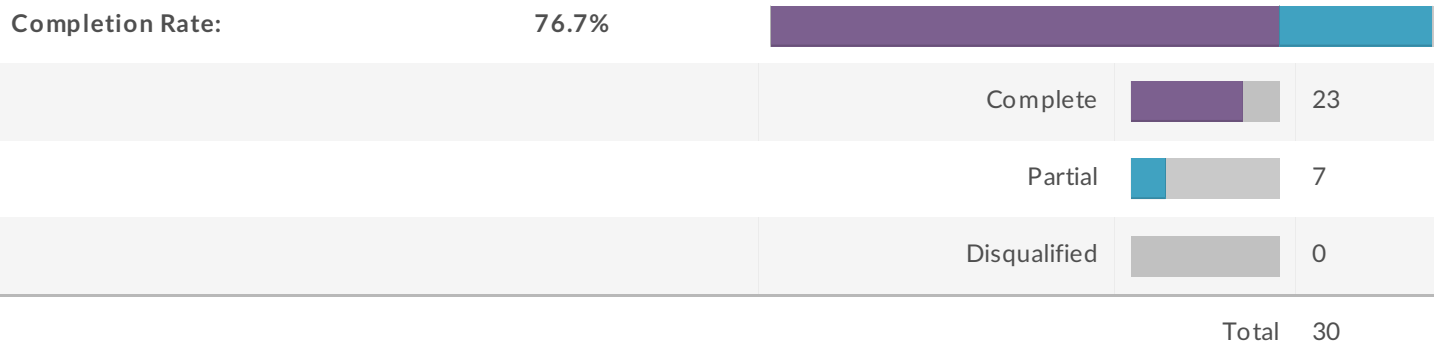
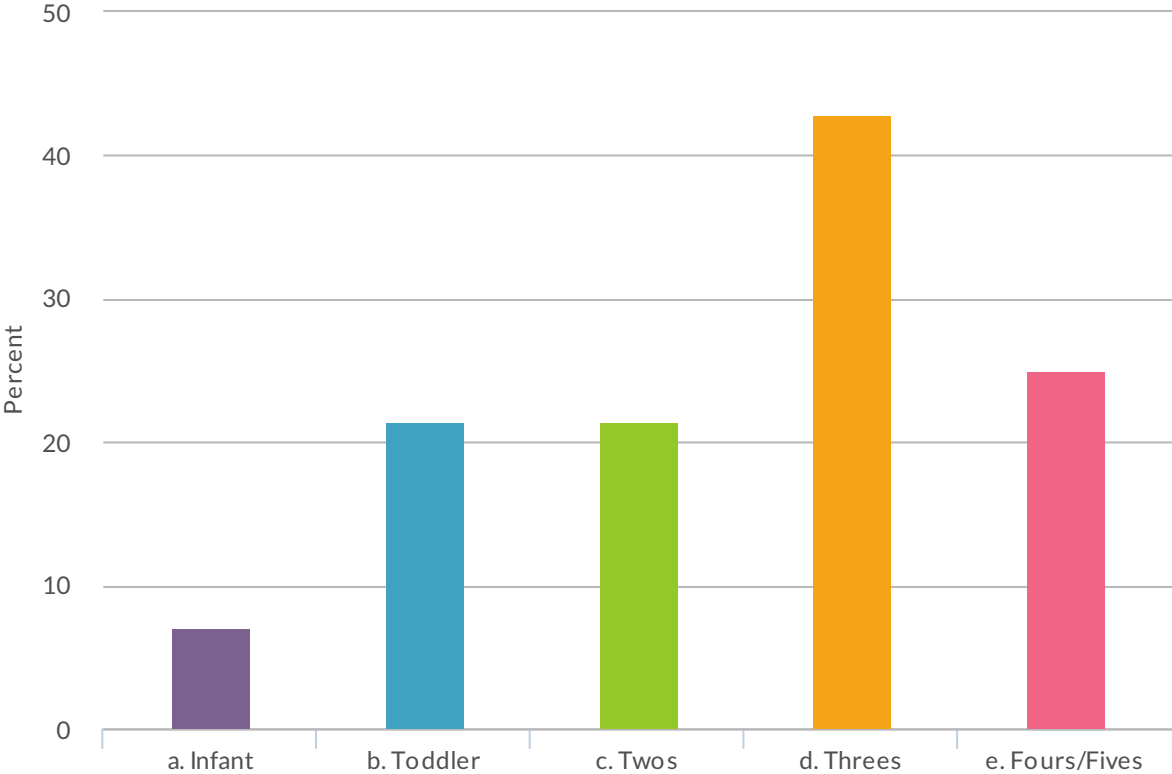

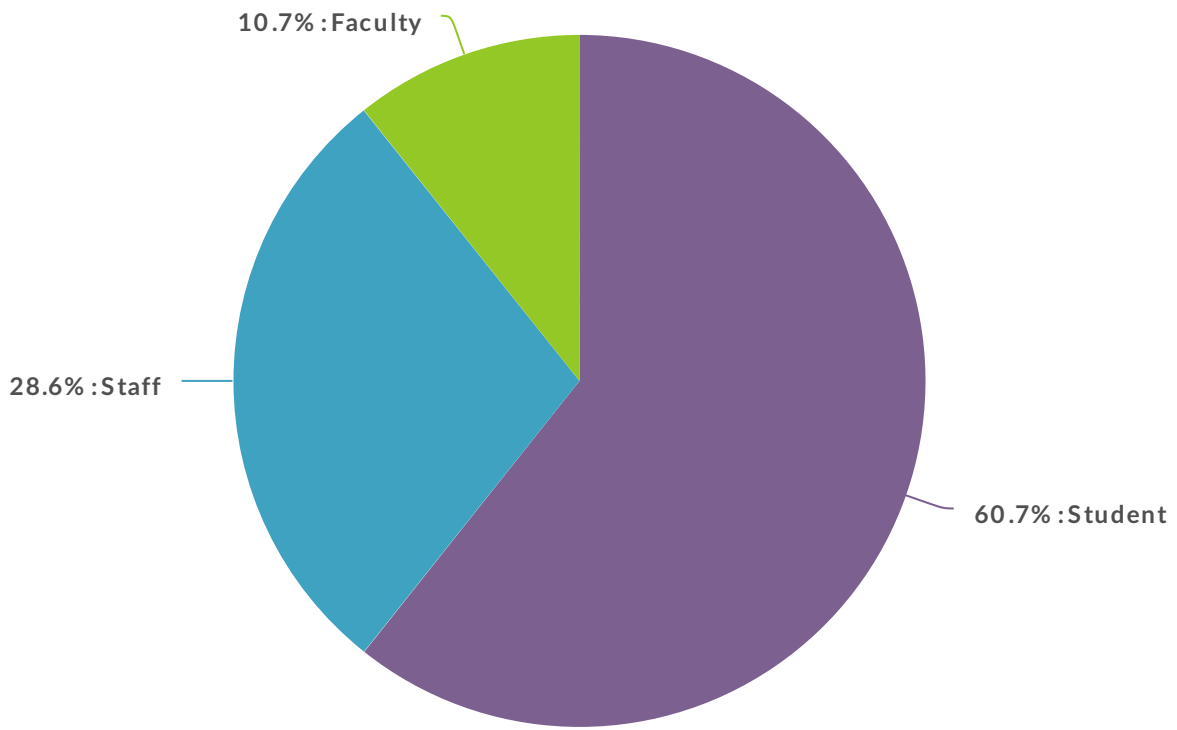


2. In which classroom is your child/ren enrolled?
(choose all that apply)



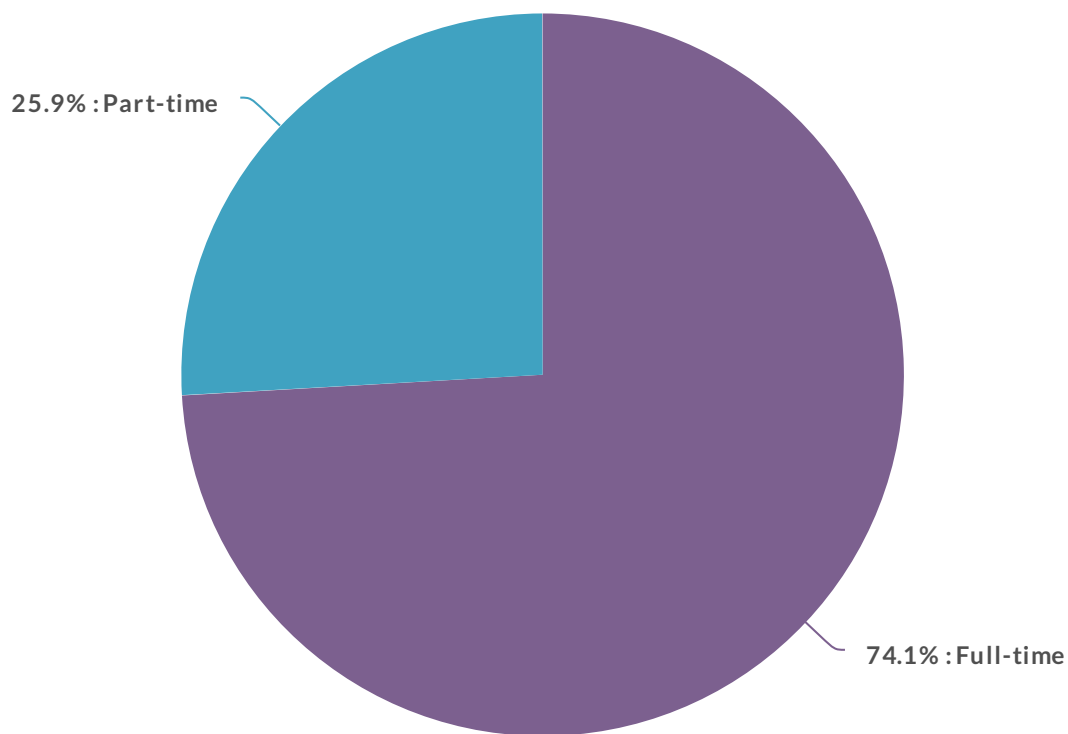

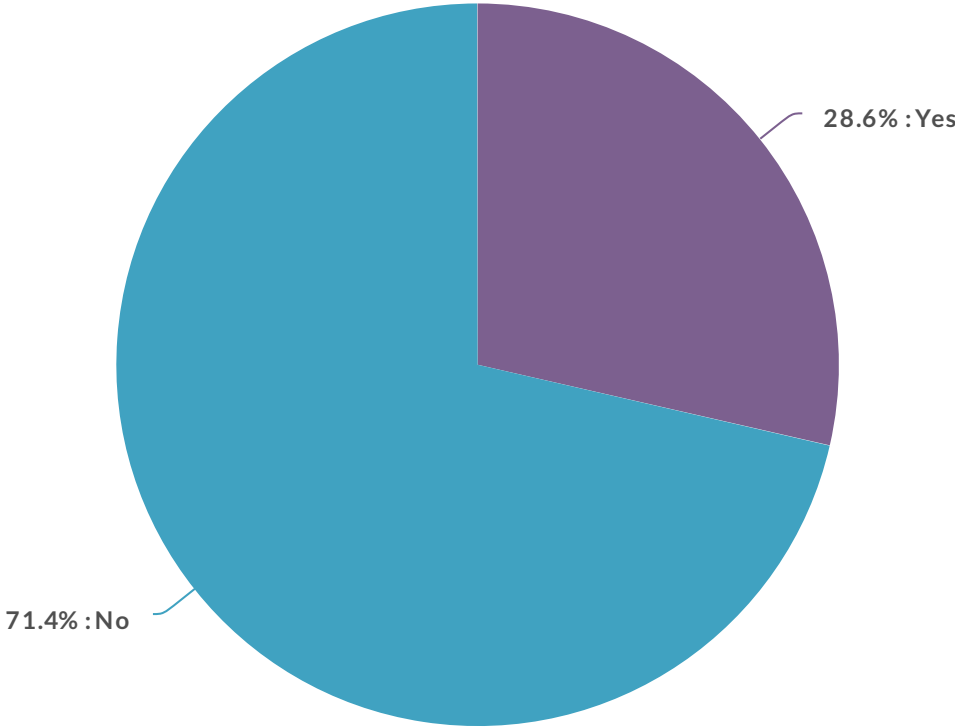

4. Is your role at NIC full or part time?



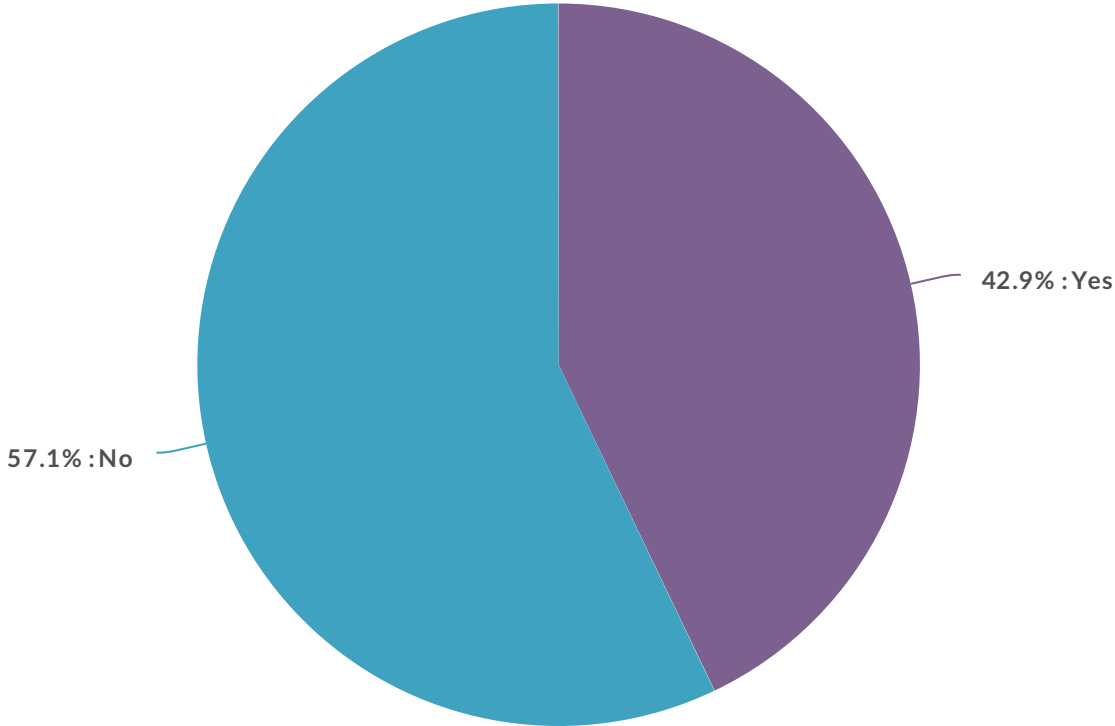

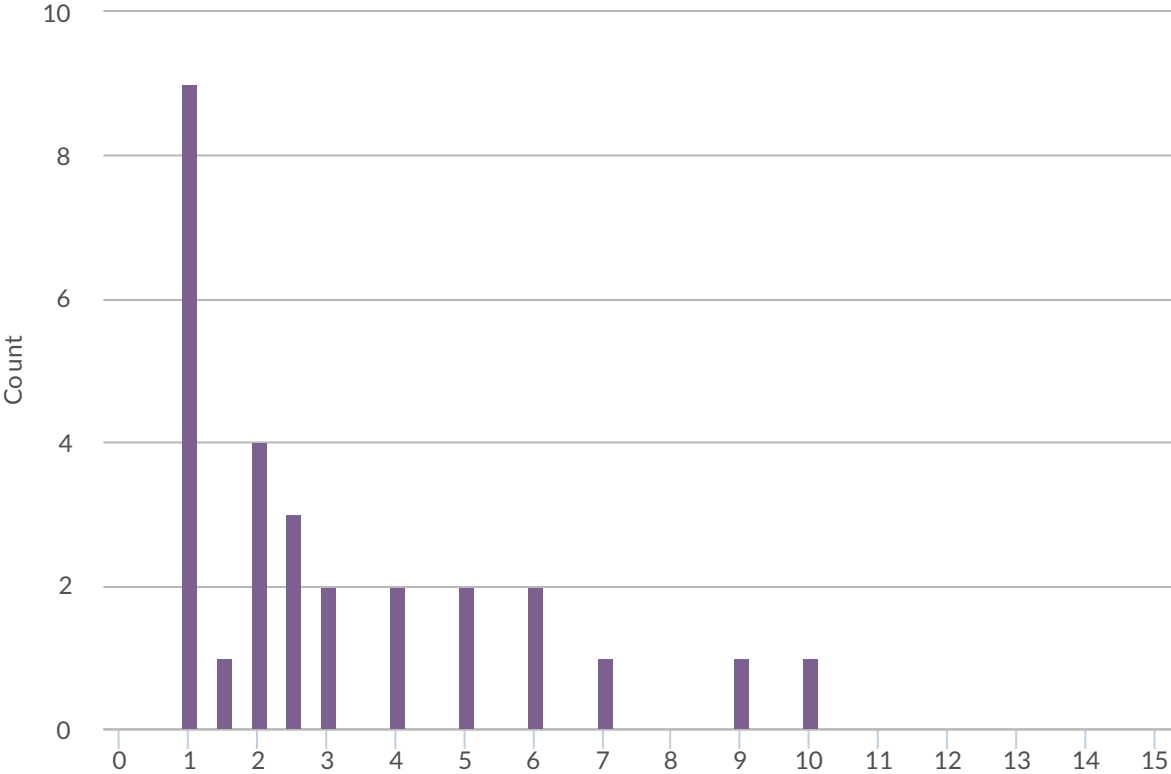

6. Do you receive ICCP benefits?

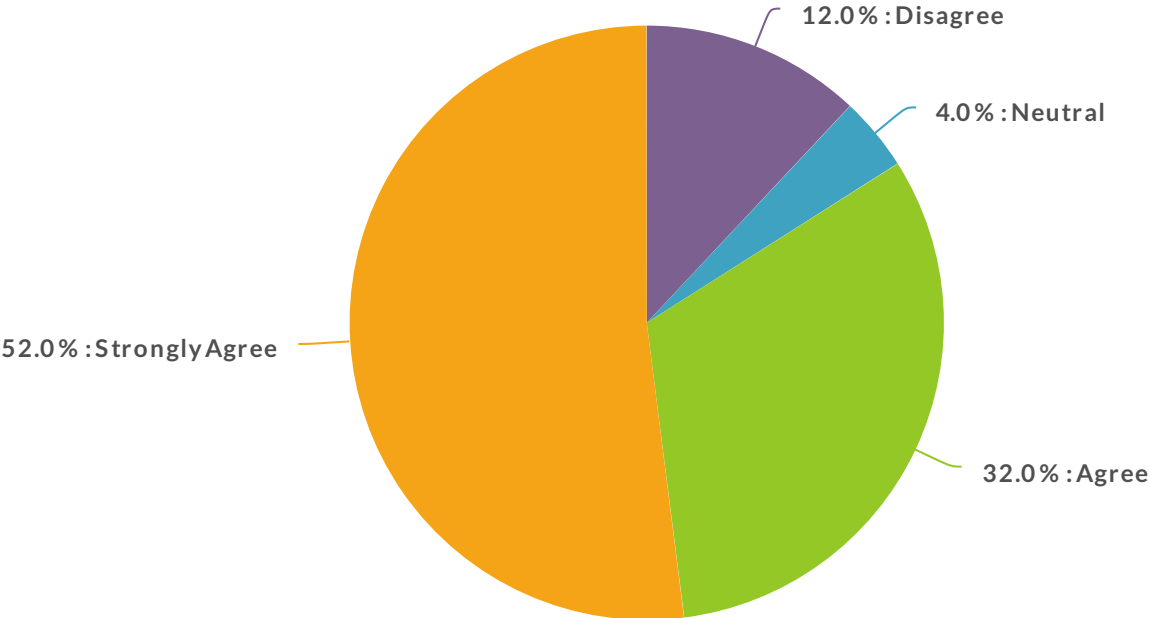

7. How many years have you used the Children's Center?

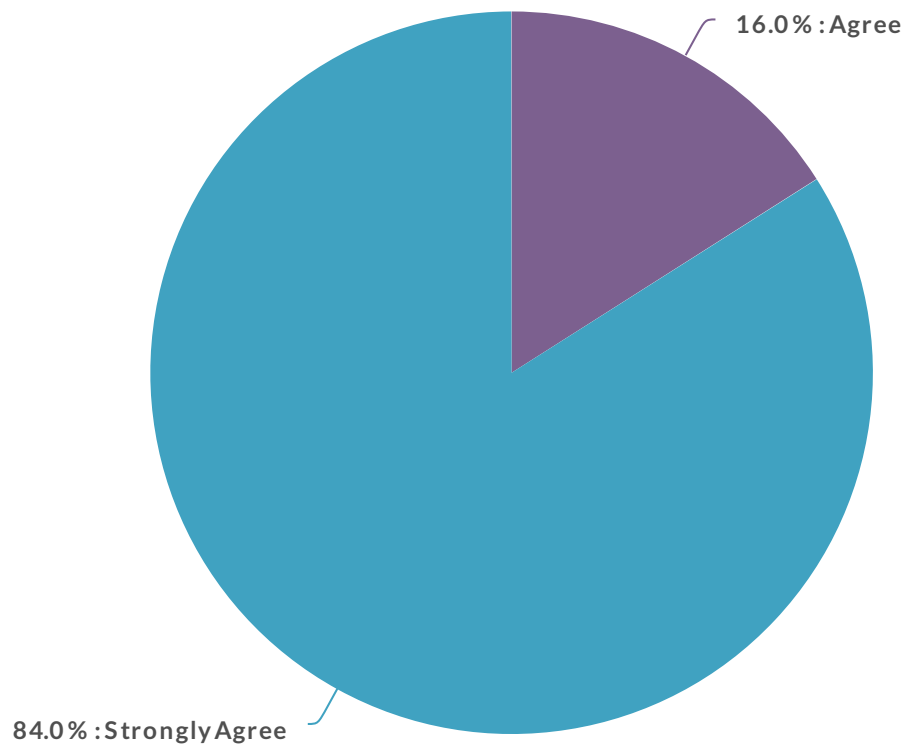


8. The Center’s hours meet my needs as a student or staff member during the academic year.



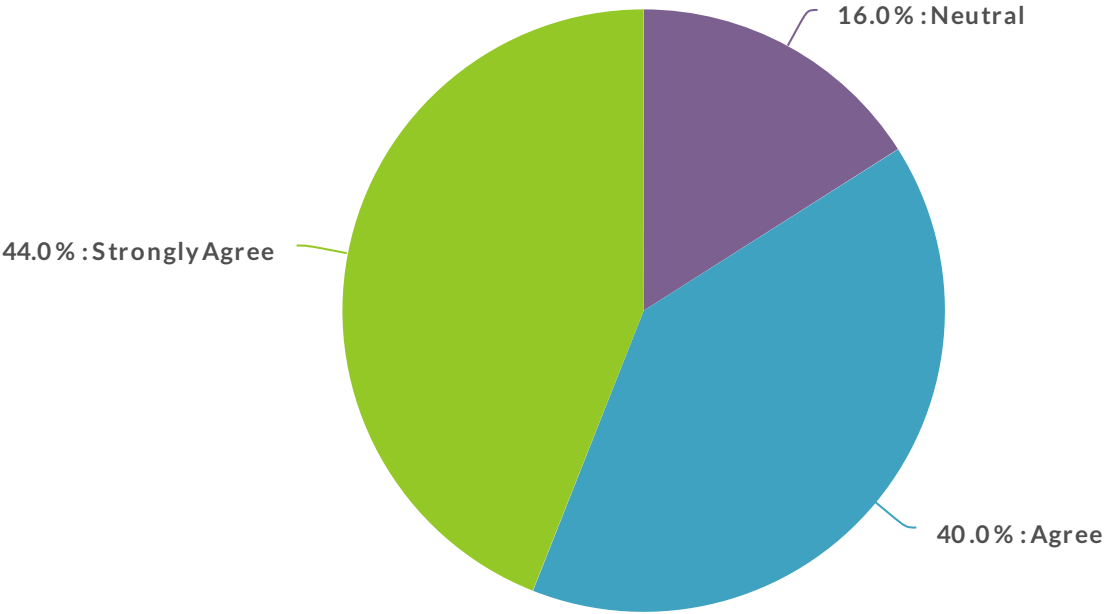

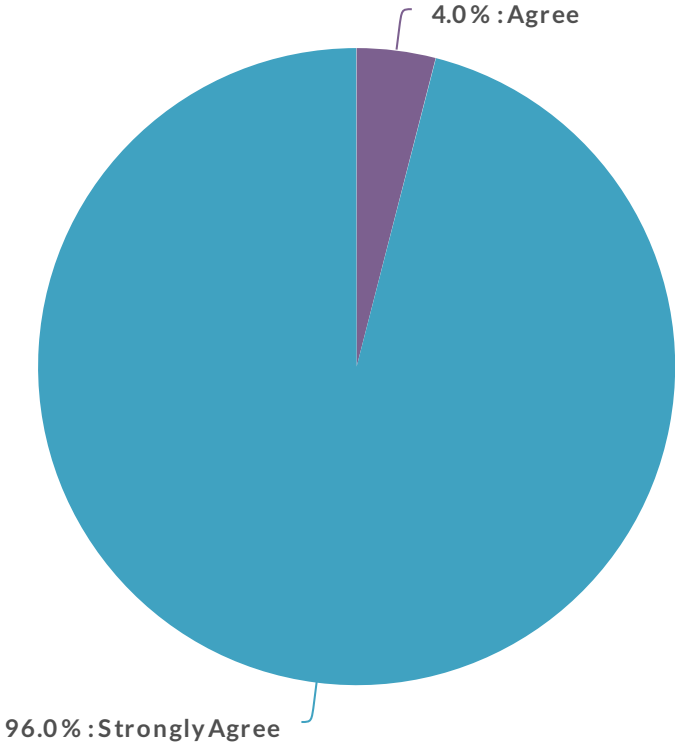

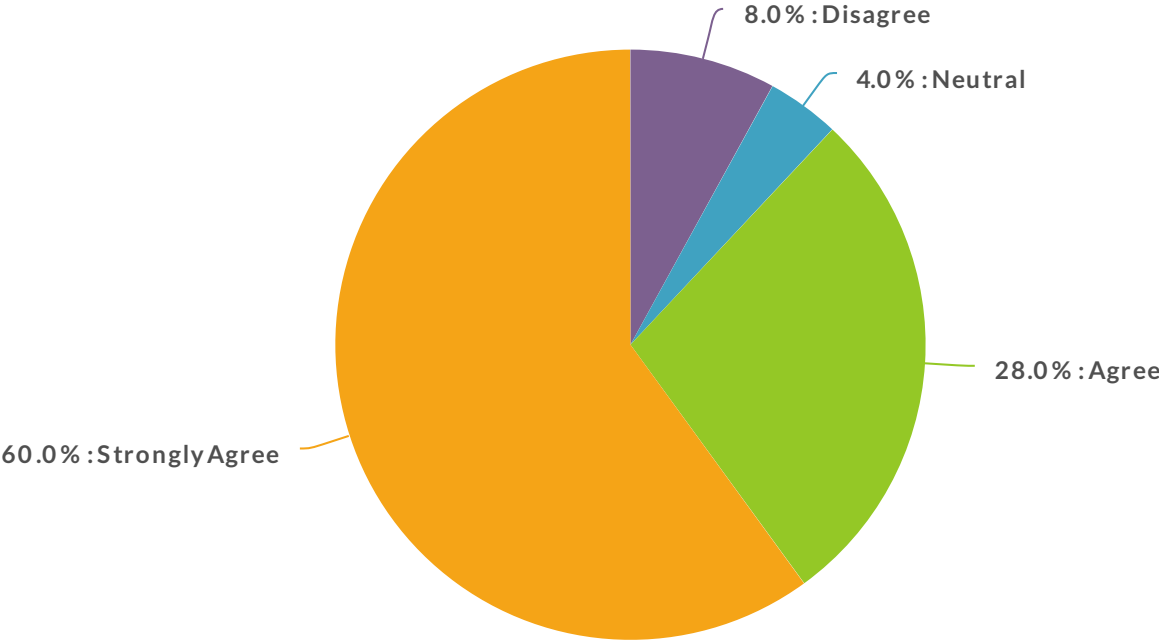

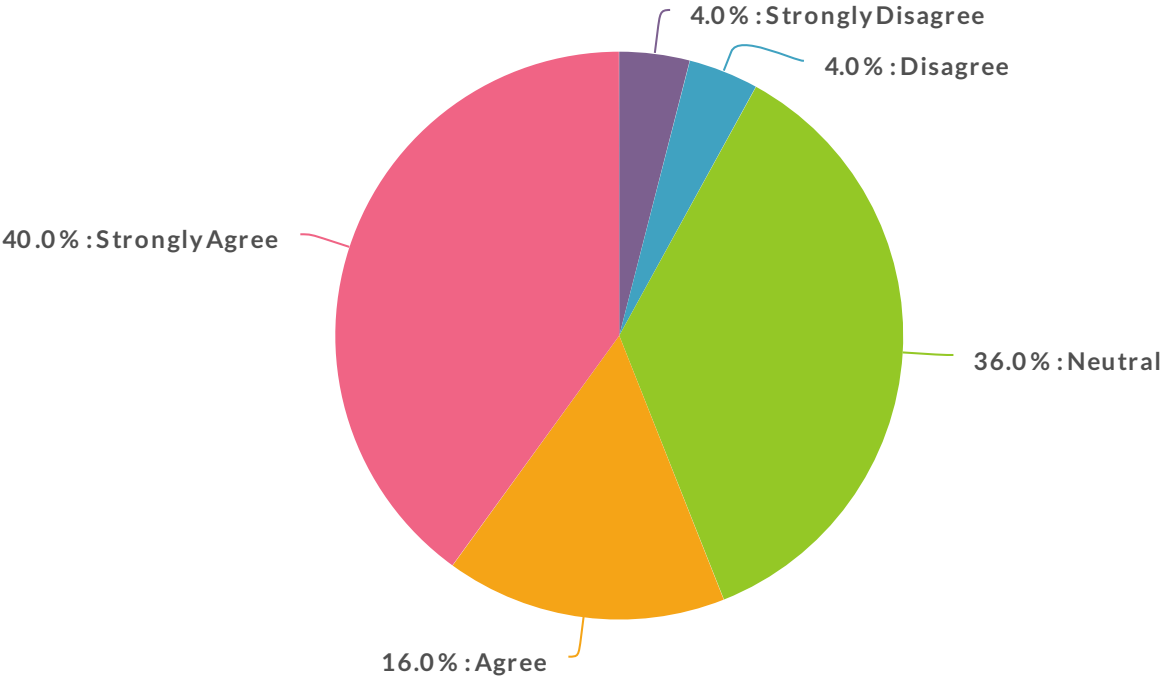

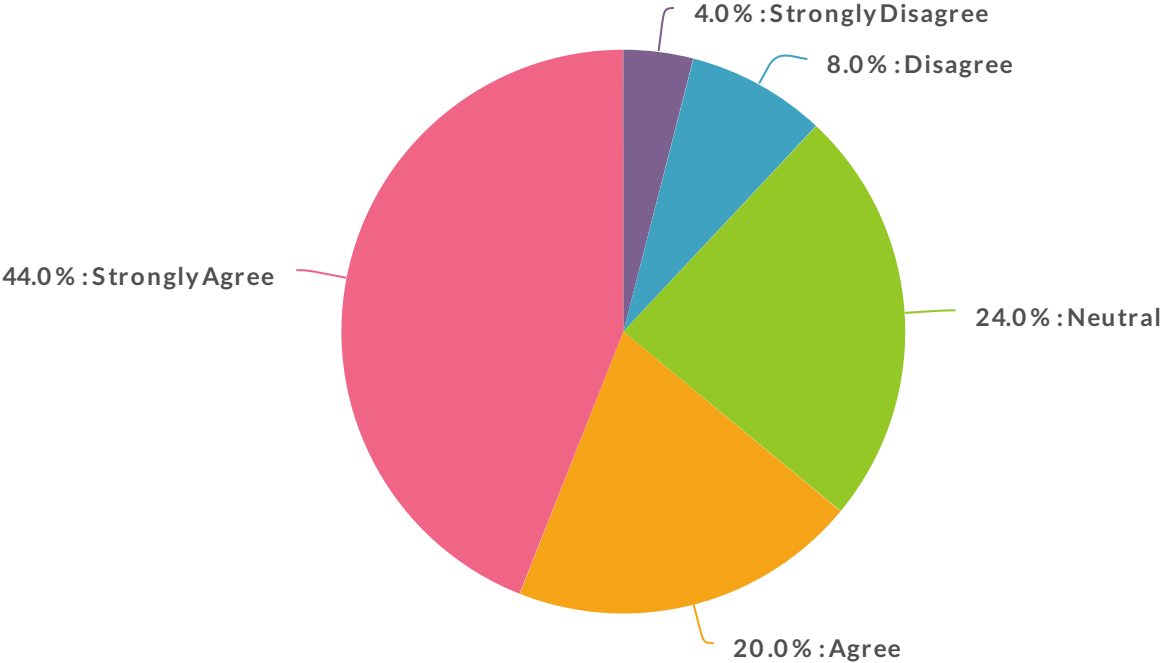

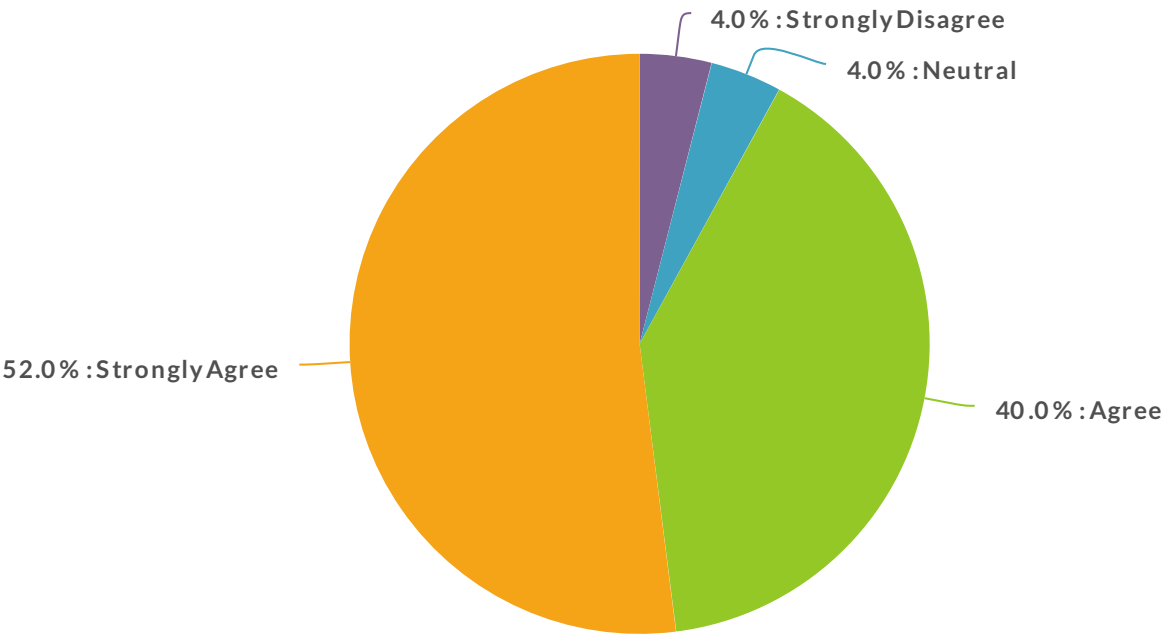

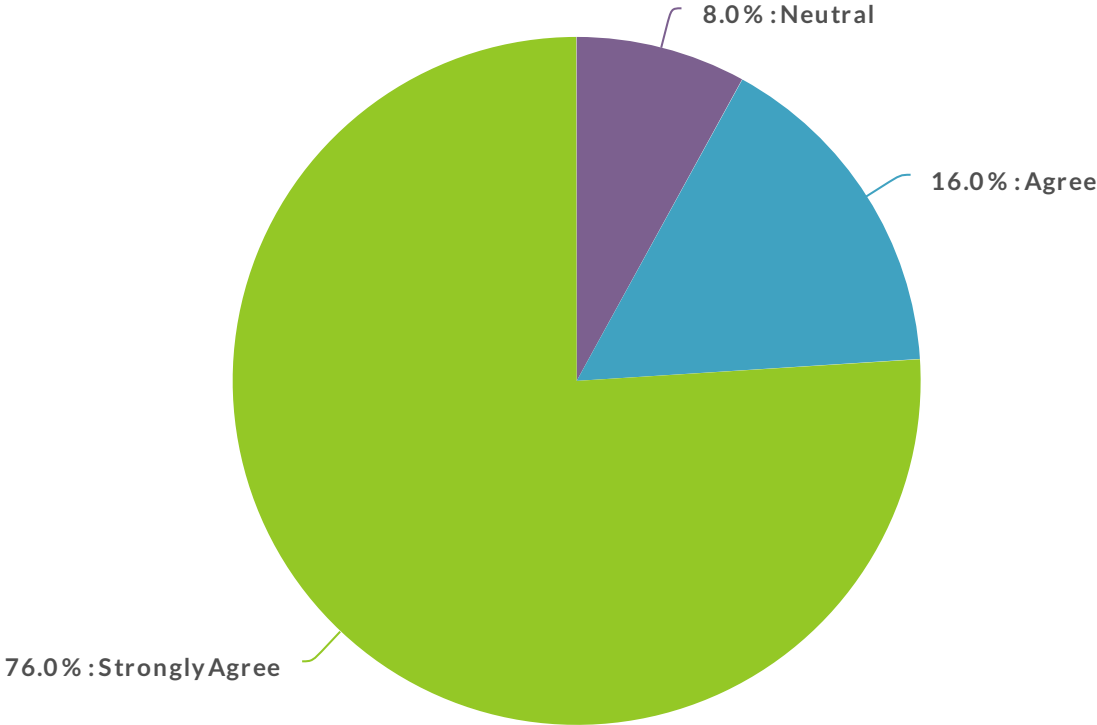

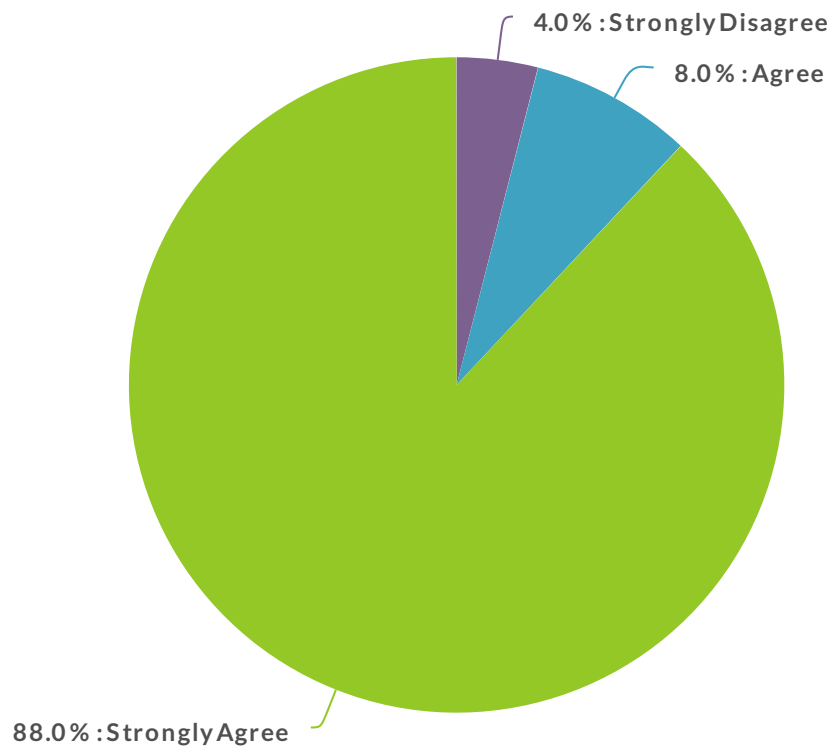

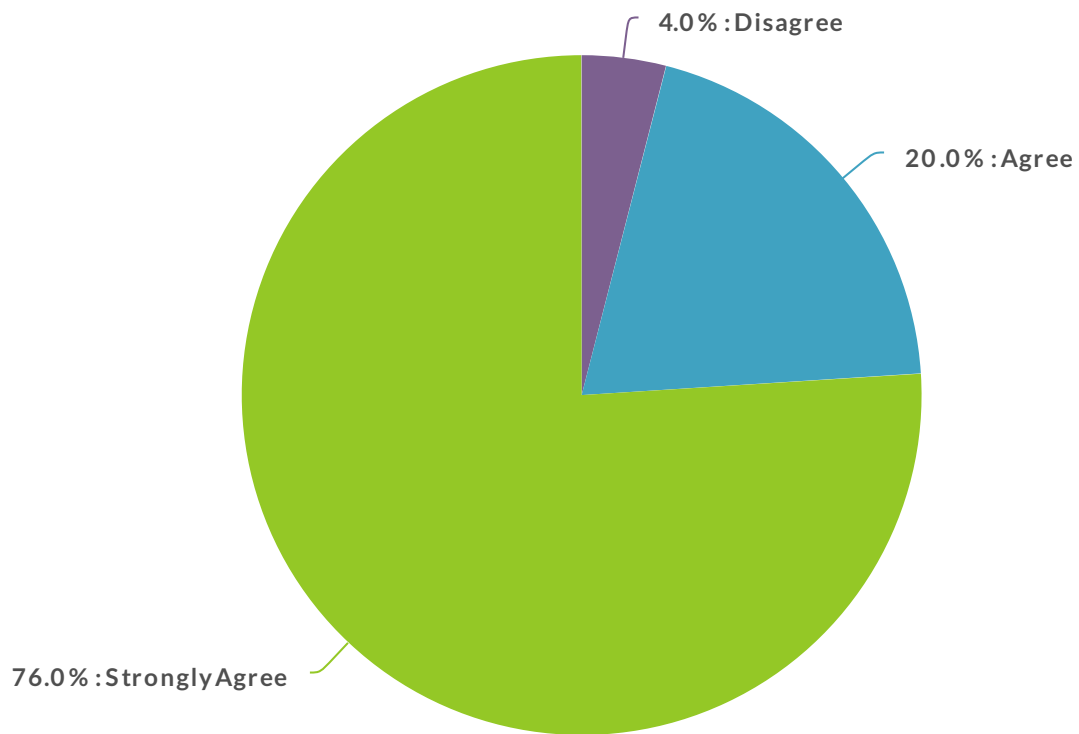

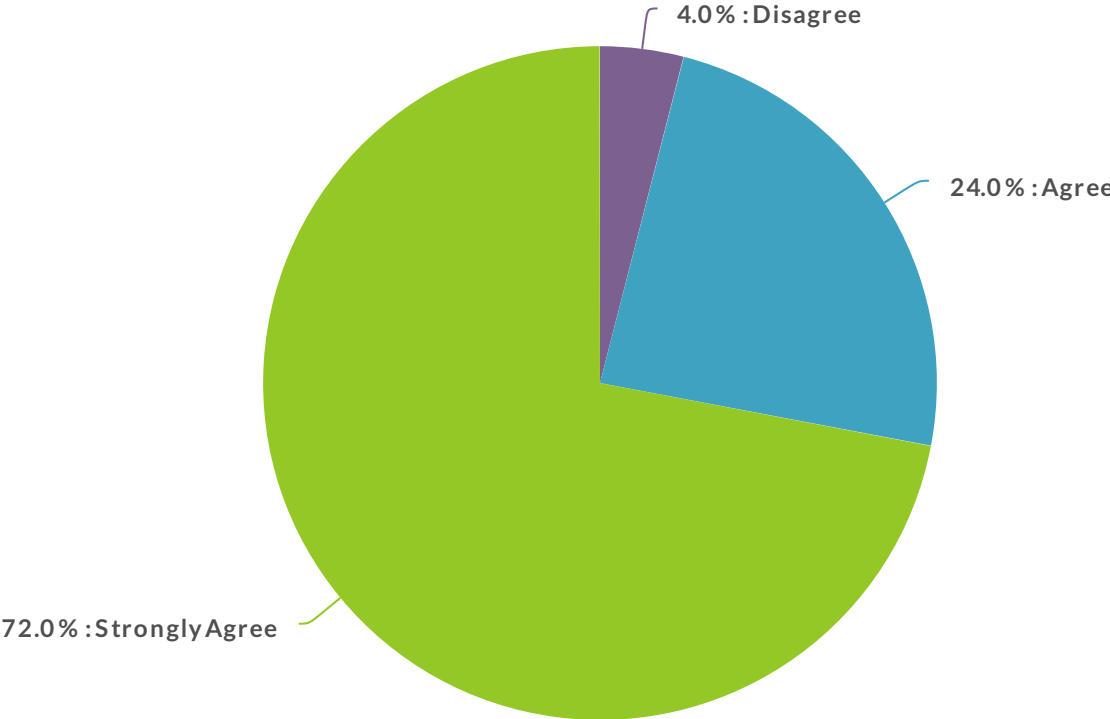

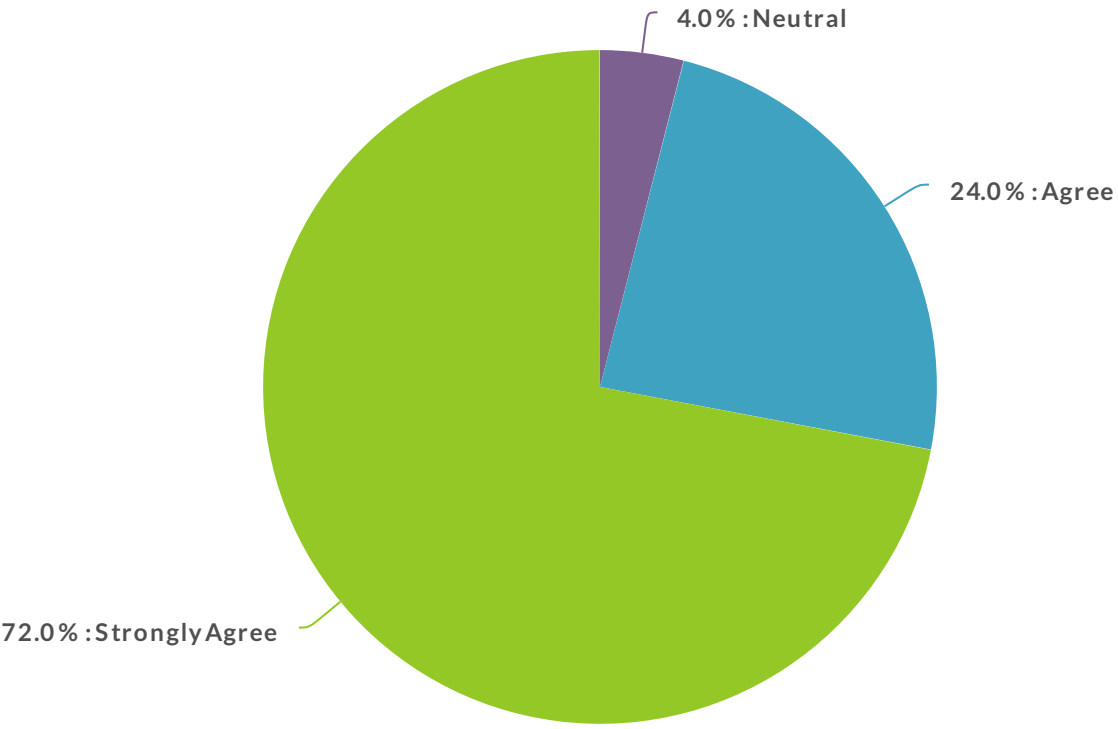

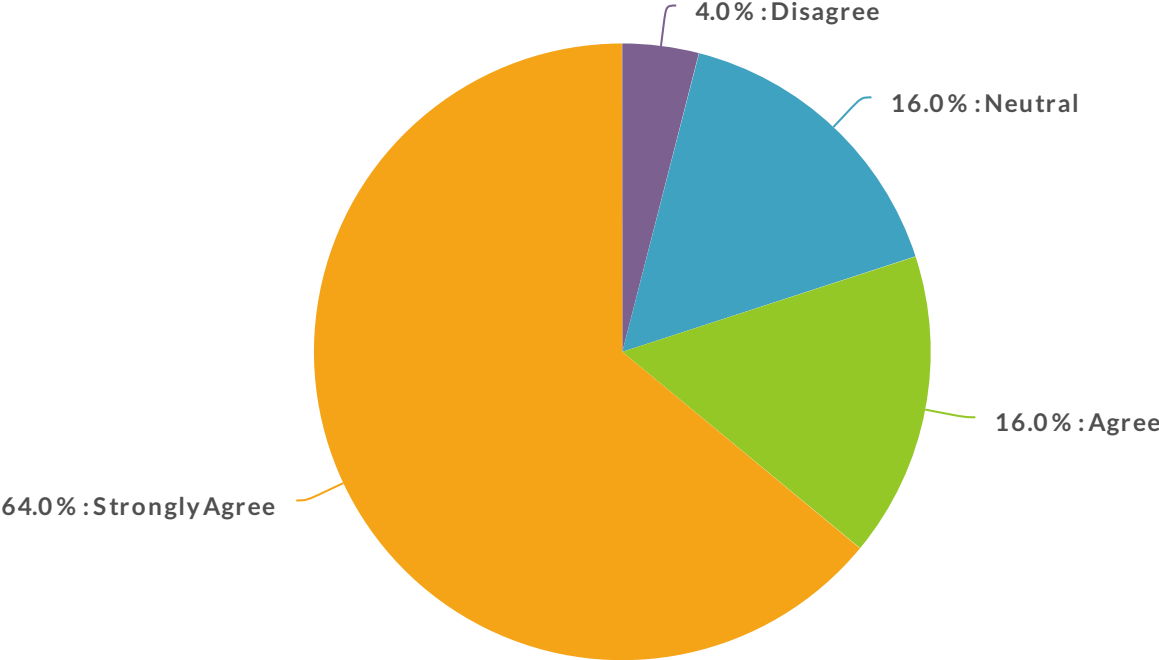

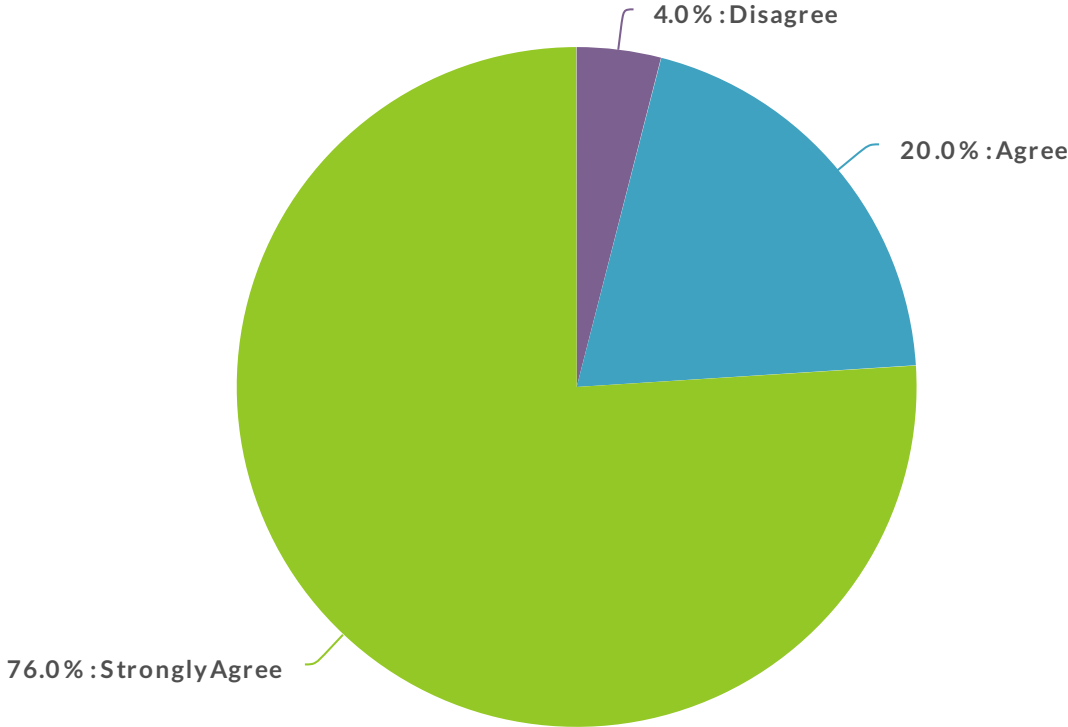

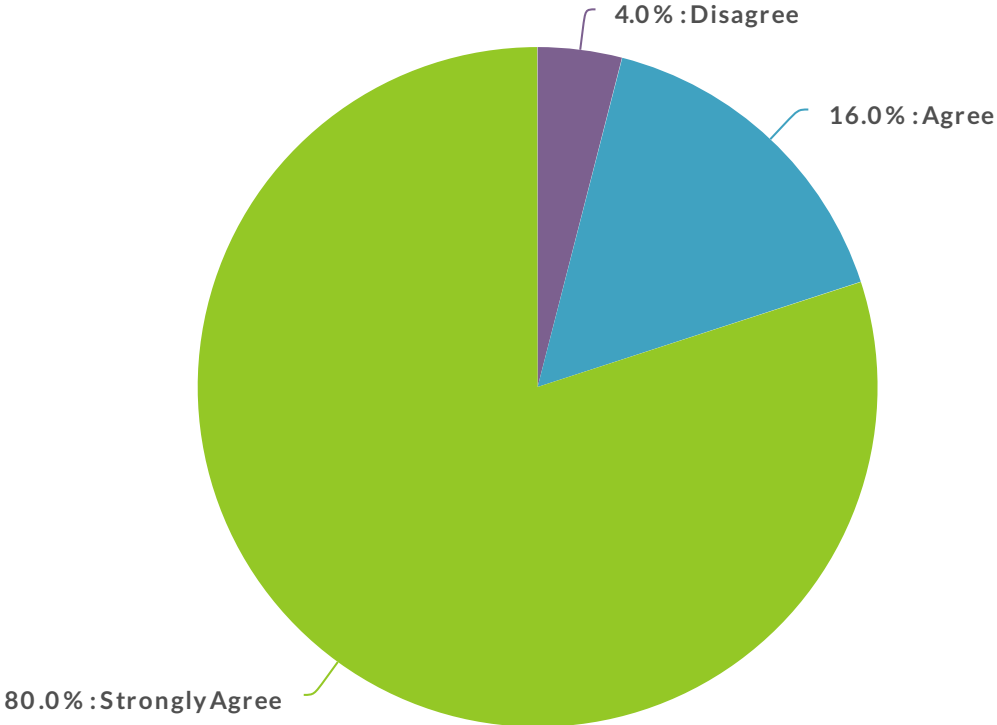

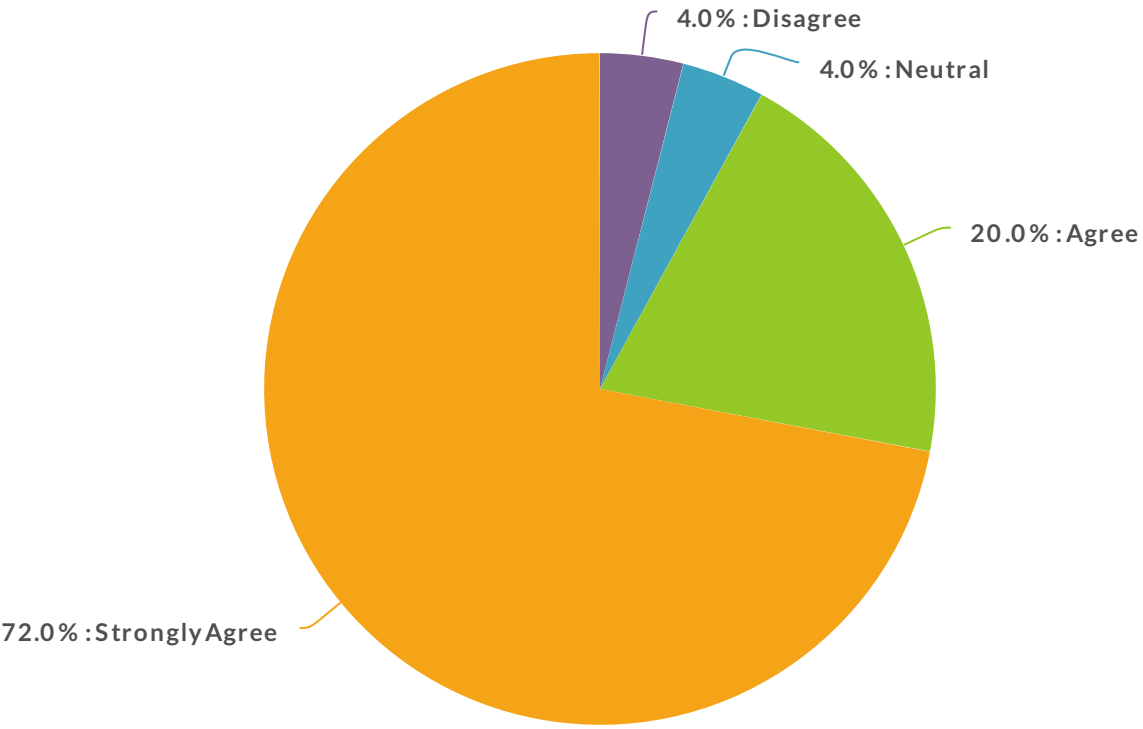

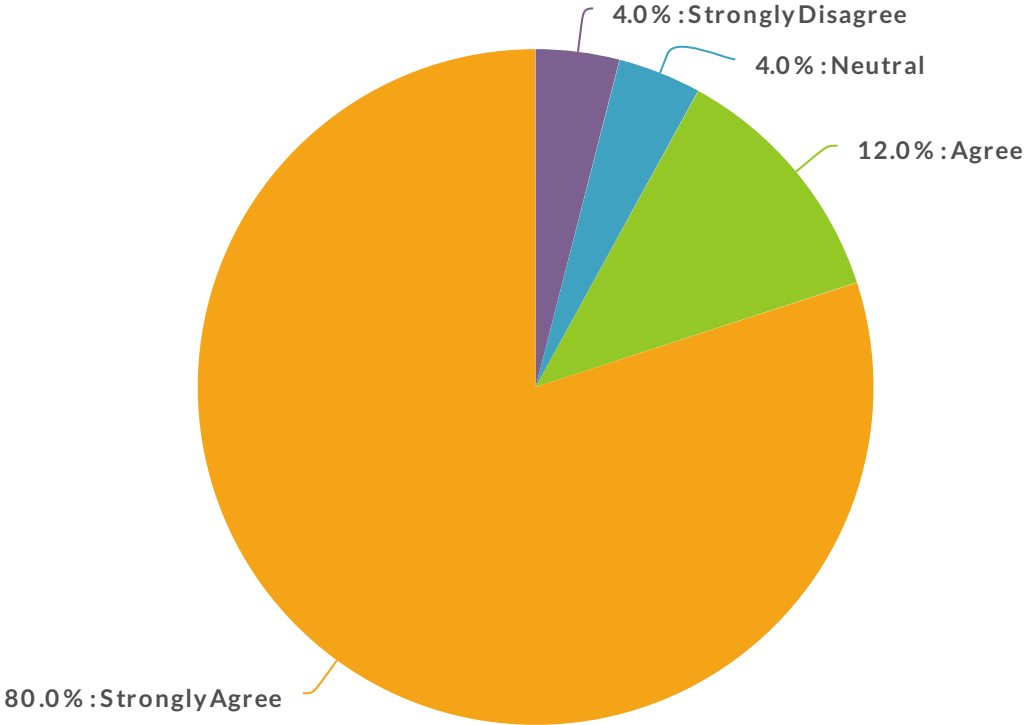

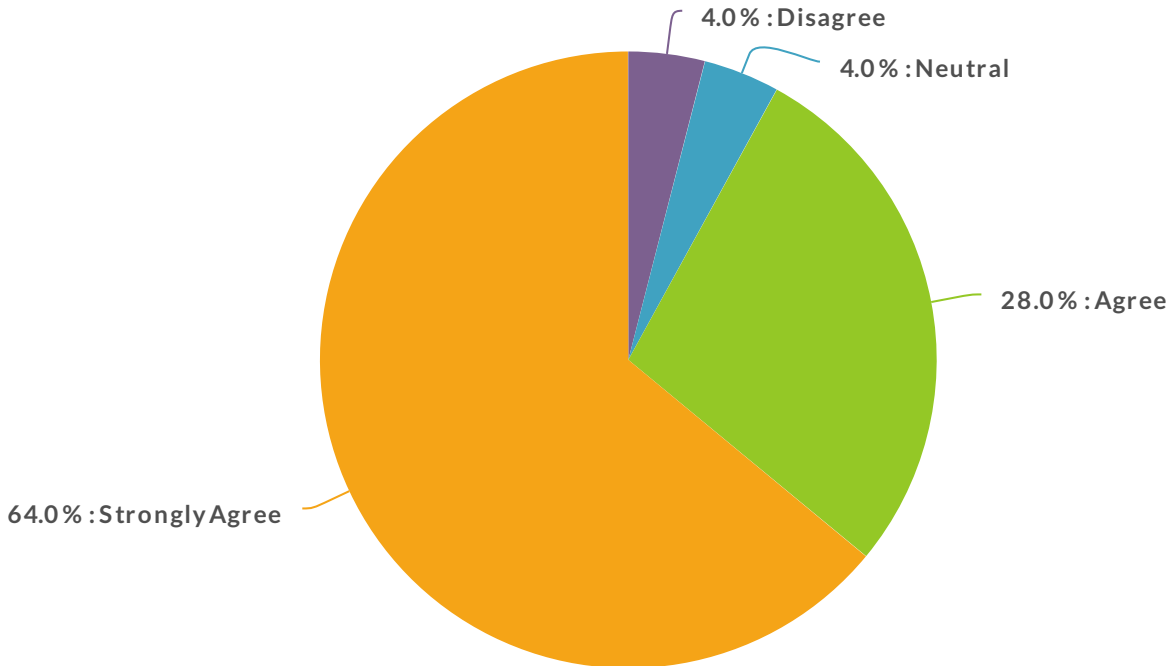

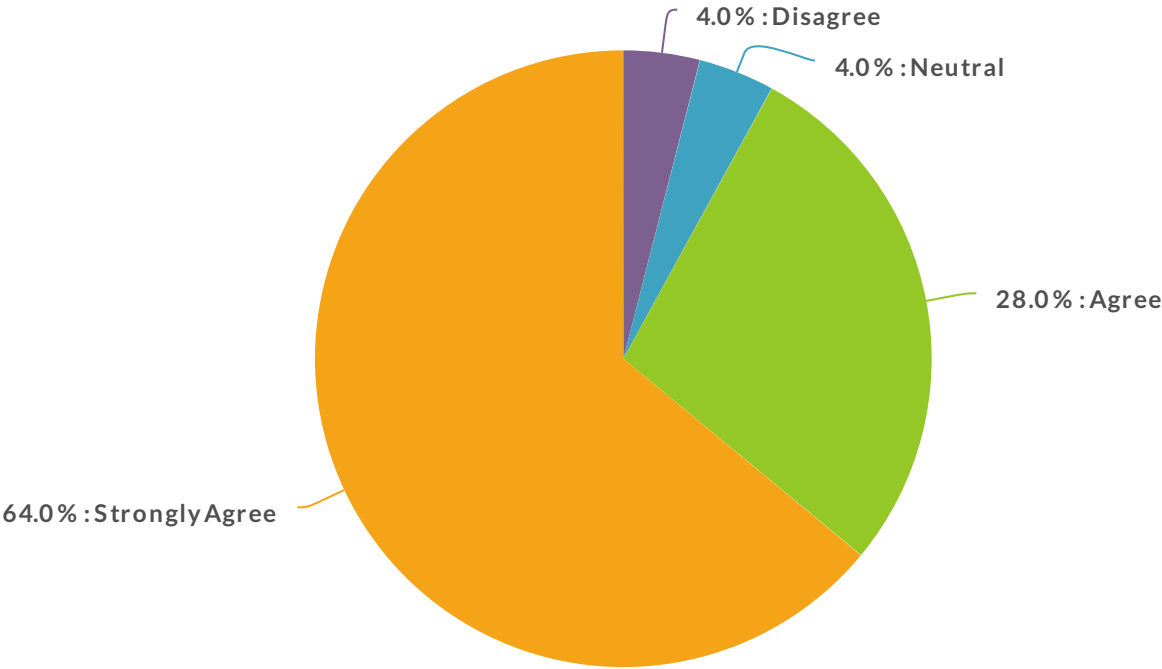

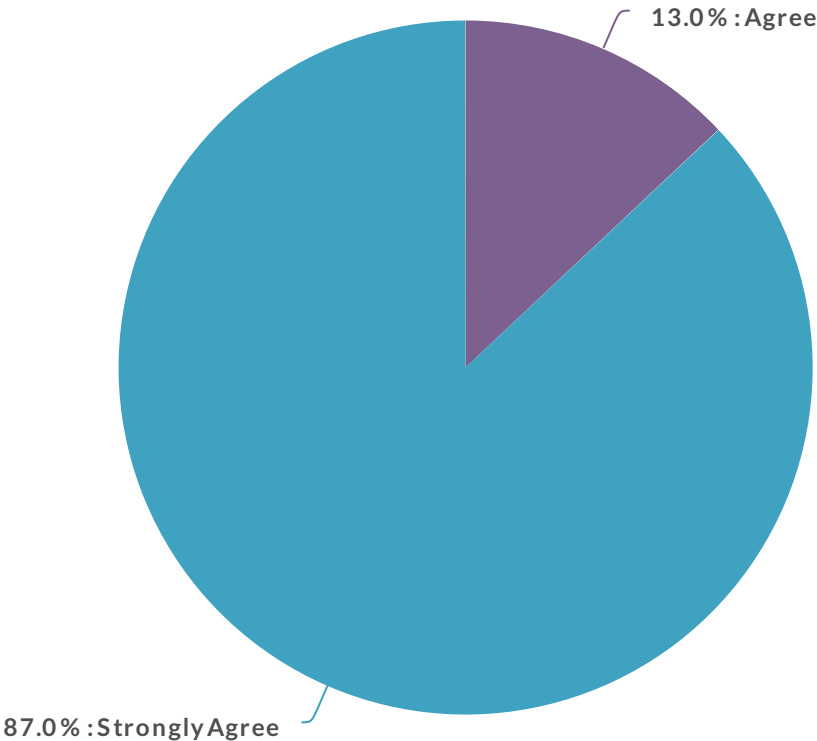

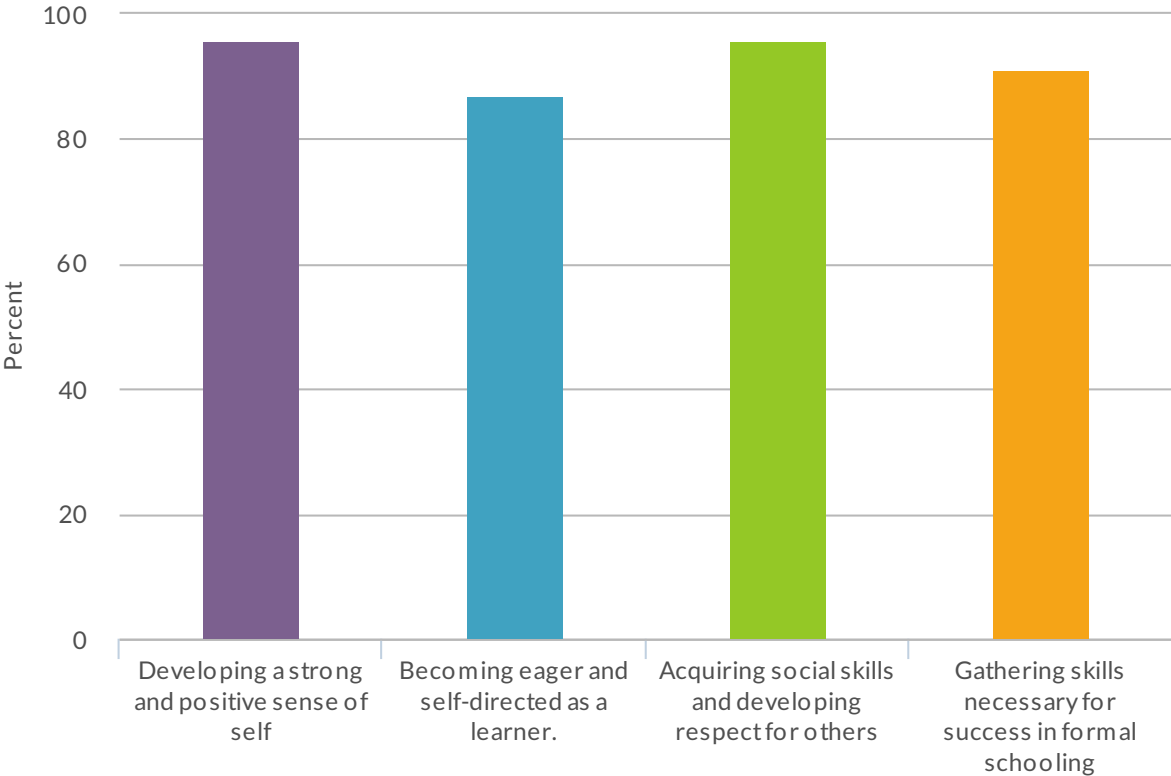

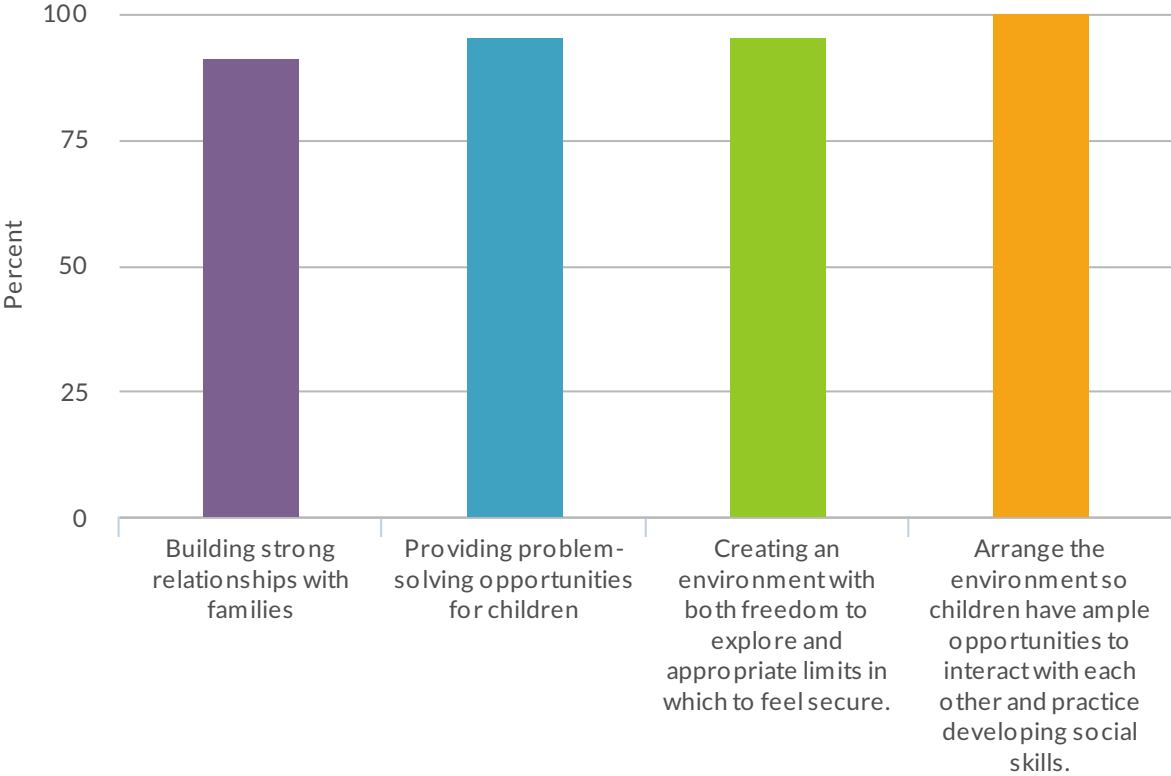

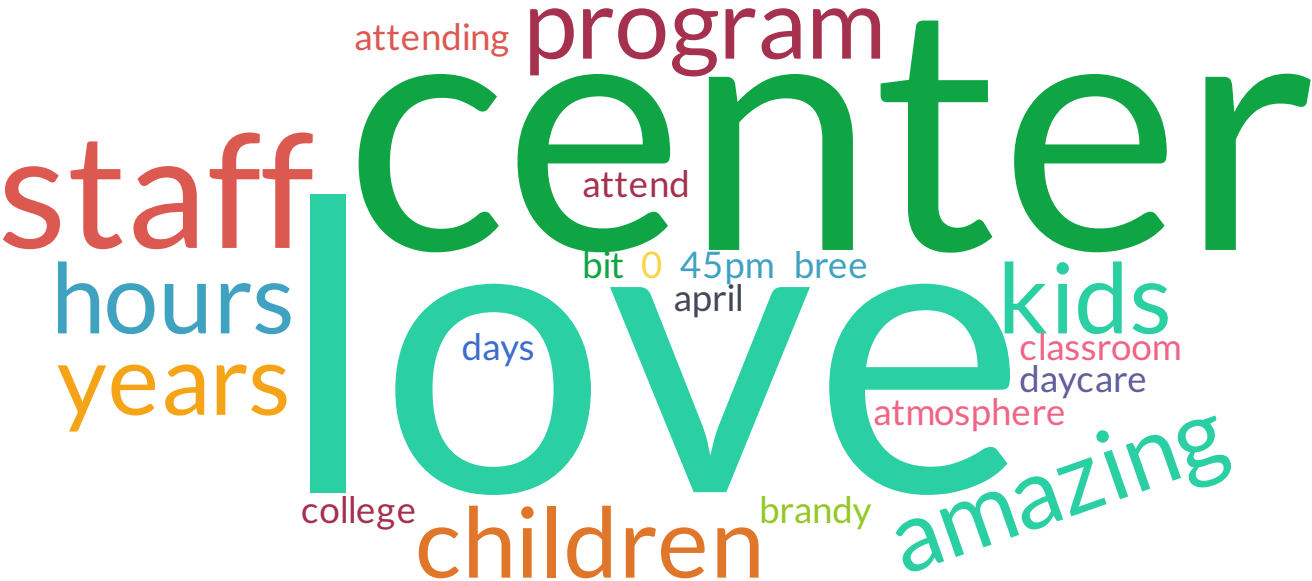
