Residency Status

Idaho Residents

Any Idaho resident, NOT from Kootenai County, must file a Certificate of Residency with his or her home county before registration. Forms are available from the NIC Admissions Office www.nic.edu/admissions/residency.asp or the Clerk/Auditors Office at your county courthouse. Some counties may require additional information, such as completing supplementary forms or filing a certificate more often. Check with your county early before the semester begins; otherwise, you may be charged higher tuition.

Former NIC students from an Idaho county other than Kootenai, please be aware: if you have completed more than six full-time semesters at NIC, you may not be eligible for the tuition benefit from your county. Students who exceed the tuition benefit will be charged non-district tuition. Please check with your county for further details.

Out-of-State Residents

Washington State Residents

Residents of the state of Washington qualify for a reduction of the out-of-state tuition rate. Residency status is determined by the date the application is received at the college.

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)
