

Section Instructional Method Definitions – unless otherwise noted in your schedule, classes begin the week of August 24.

Activity	ACT	Section where the instructional time is based on a physical activity.
Hybrid	HYB	Section that combines face-to-face and online instruction.
Hybrid Flex	HYBF	Section combining rotating face-to-face instruction at set days and times with online instruction not at set days and times.
Hybrid Set	HYBS	Section combining rotating face-to-face instruction at set days and times with online instruction at the same set days and times.
Hybrid Originating Site	HYBO	Section combining online and face-to-face with instructor present using video conferencing technology.
Hybrid Receiving Site	HYBR	Section combining online and remote instruction using video conferencing technology.
Internship	ITR	Section that requires placement outside an NIC classroom for students to gain experience in a chosen career.
IVC Originating Site	IVCO	Section taught face-to-face with instructor present using video conferencing technology.
IVC Receiving Site	IVCR	Section taught with remote instruction using video conferencing technology.
Lab	LAB	Section taught face-to-face with laboratory instruction.
Lecture	LEC	Section taught face-to-face.
Lecture/Lab	LL	Section taught face-to-face that combines lecture and lab instruction.
Online	OLINE	Section taught online with no set meeting times.
Online Lab	OLAB	Section taught online with laboratory instruction at set days and times.
Online Lecture	OLEC	Section taught online at set days and times.
Online Plus	OPLUS	Section taught online with no set meeting times but will require proctored quizzes/exams.
Practicum	PRC	Section which provide supervised application of previous coursework learned.
Orientation	ORT	In combination with one the above instructional methods used to orient a student.
