

Helps seniors maintain a safe and clean home environment:

- Changing linens
- Assisting with laundry
- Cleaning bathroom & kitchen
- Cleaning floors & dusting
- Taking out the trash
- Applicants must be age 60 or older and have physical or cognitive deficits that prevent them from performing basic cleaning activities.

# Nutrition HDM/Cong

- HDM (home delivered meals) provides up to 5 meals/week for each qualified person.
- Meals are prepared by local senior centers
- Meals are provided at no charge, however, donations are vital to supporting the program.
- Applicants must be homebound, 60 or older, frail (physical or cognitive deficits), and unable to independently prepare meals.
- AAANI reimbursement rate is \$4.20 & \$4.50 per meal



## **FY24 Calls & Visits**

Our Customer Service Dept. (I&A) takes approximately 80 calls/week to connect seniors and their caregivers to vital services in the 5 northern counties.

FY24 had 848 Adult Protection Service reports come in from concerned citizens

Our Ombudsman Program is responsible for 76 facilities or approximately 2800 beds in care facilities

- **Self-Directed Transportation Program**
  - Consumer gets to choose who transports them
- **Friendly Caller Program**
  - Volunteers who call home-bound seniors and visit with them
- **Honoring Choices**
  - Assistance in filling out your advanced care directives
- **Introduction to Brain Health & Community Resources w/Alz Assoc.**
  - Community Educational Class twice/month
- **Habitat for Humanity**
  - Wheelchair Ramps & minor home repairs
