Dear Dr. Swayne:

After review of the requested progress report, the continuing accreditation status of the associate degree radiography program sponsored by North Idaho College was considered at the April 17, 2026 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. The program was evaluated according to the **Standards for an Accredited Educational Program in Radiography (2021)**. The program now documents compliance with all relevant Standards; therefore, the JRCERT awards:

**ACCREDITATION FOR A PERIOD OF SEVEN YEARS.**

Consistent with JRCERT Policy 10.100, this accreditation action is not subject to appeal.

This equates to an award of seven years of accreditation effective from the date of the most recent site visit.

The next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the Third Quarter of 2027. The continuing accreditation materials will be forwarded to the program at a future date and will include a submission timetable.

The JRCERT does not believe that the recent adverse actions by the institutional accreditor have impacted the educational quality of the program. Accordingly, the program's request to increase the program total capacity from 16 to 20 has been approved.


The program is advised that the Teach-Out Plan, in support of the previous adverse action, is no longer applicable.

The program is also advised that consistent with JRCERT Policy 11.600, the JRCERT reserves the right to conduct unannounced site visits to accredited programs. The sponsoring institution would be responsible for the expenses of any onsite evaluation.
