An education and training grant program that provides students a one-time opportunity to have 80% of the tuition and fees at North Idaho College covered up to a maximum amount of \$8,000.

4-YEAR INSTITUTION

Opportunity Scholarship

Awards eligible applicants up to \$3,500 per academic year and is renewable for up to four years.
